

Silk Painting with Mary Sly

November 11-12, 2017. Skagit College, San Juan

This will be a wonderful opportunity to study with one of San Juan's most accomplished artists. You will create two or three paintings using resist techniques and jacquard red label dyes. Design elements, composition, pattern, contrast, and value will also be discussed. You will create color samples to compare wet dyes to finished results. The first day will be about drawing and practice. Samples will be steam set and rinsed. On the second day, you will create the finished pieces.

Materials fee: \$40

Mary lives and creates on San Juan Island, but she shows and sells her work nationally at prestigious craft shows, such as at the Smithsonian and Philadelphia Museum shows. Mary is, "fascinated by the intersection of light and colors, between nature and the artist's perspective, and then the physical reality of creating an image."

Workshop fee: \$60-\$75 (\$30 deposit required)
